



Cozy Layette

Robe:

1. Cut one from both lining and robe fabric, being sure to place the top edge on fold of fabric
2. With RIGHT sides together, stitch from a to b on both lining and robe fabric.
3. Place robe fabric unit RIGHT sides together with lining unit: pin matching seams
4. Stitch all the way around, leaving enough of an opening along the bottom for turning.
5. Turn, press and close opening, either by hand or top stitching
6. Add velcro dot at the X
7. Embellish with tiny lace, ribbons or buttons

Blanket

1. Cut a 7 1/2 inch square from fabric and lining (You may want to add very thin batting)
2. Stitch with RIGHT sides together, leaving an opening large enough for turning
3. Turn, press, topstitch
4. Embellish as desired with tiny lace, ribbon or buttons or quilt the heart design in the center.

NOTE: Please use only soft pastel or white fabric of the highest quality. These must be beautiful!

"Cozy"
(Fetal Demise Layette)

- Cut 2:
 - * 1 from white or very pastel pink or blue flannel for the inside
 - * 1 from a soft fabric, either white, pastel pink or blue, or a tiny print for the outside
- Sew the four corners on both the lining and the outside, matching A to A, B to B, etc, with Right Sides Together, using a 1/8" seam
- Set the lining into the outside, with Right Sides Together
- Stitch around the top, using a 1/4" seam, leaving about 2" on one long side for turning
- Turn and press the opening closed
- Top-stitch around the top, very close to the edge, so that you catch the pressed opening
- Take tiny "tucks" where noted on the four sides.
- Embellish the two longer sides at the "tuck" with tiny ribbon, bows, appliques, or buttons
